

Screen Print FAQ's

What is screen printing?

Screen printing is a stencil method of printing by which a design is imaged onto a screen of emulsified mesh where ink is forced through the mesh stencil onto the printing surface. This method produces high quality printed apparel that can withstand years of wash and wear.

How is the price determined?

Pricing for screen printing is determined by the quantity of items being printed, the color of the garment, the number of print locations, and the number of colors in the designs.

What is the minimum quantity to order?

Only 12 units are required for custom screen print orders.

What is the turn around time for custom apparel?

Typical turn around time is two weeks from the time your order is placed until the day it would ship. This turn around time depends on the size of the order, the work required to prepare your design or logo for printing, and the confirmation of your e-proof.

What is an "ART CHARGE?"

In order to prepare your custom design for printing, it may need to be formatted to be color separated or vectored. This charge is based on the complexity of the design. Choose from our stock images for a one-time set up fee of \$10 per color.

How do I submit my logo or design?

You can upload your art file or image while placing your order, or later e-mail it to art@bjscustomcreations.com

Can I get an actual sample?

Due to the amount of prep time required to set-up the screen printing production machines, sample printed garments are usually not practical for small orders. To assure your order is accurate, we will provide you with an e-proof of your design to approve before production can begin. Blank items can be purchased for sizing purposes also.
